



Many gardeners purchase beneficial insects themselves, including the Spined Soldier Bug, and release them into their control areas. However, with this method there are no guarantees that the Soldier Bug won't leave the area in search of other prey. With the RESCUE!® Soldier Bug Attractor, this beneficial insect is lured into an area and kept in residence throughout the second and third generation hatchlings of the destructive pest insects.

**What it is**

The RESCUE!® Soldier Bug Attractor is a small, bright yellow cone designed to be hung in a tree or placed into the soil surface. The cone houses a pheromone lure which attracts the Spined Soldier Bug.

Sterling International has the exclusive rights to market the pheromone to attract the Spined Soldier Bug. We worked in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Agriculture to develop this product.

**How it works**

If you live in the Eastern U.S. or the Great Lakes area, the RESCUE!® Soldier Bug Attractor will attract the Spined Soldier Bug to your garden to provide natural pest control. We like to think of it as “nature taking care of nature.”

Once attracted, the Spined Soldier Bugs will reproduce to increase the protection and natural pest control in the garden, orchard and other foliage areas. The Soldier Bugs will eat the destructive pests while leaving your garden or orchard intact.

Once the plastic covering is removed, the RESCUE!® Soldier Bug Attractor is potent for 60 days

**When it works**

The most advantageous time to use the RESCUE!® Soldier Bug Attractor is one week before bud-burst of the Red Maple tree, which normally occurs in:

IOWA	2nd week March
ILLINOIS	3rd week March
OHIO	3rd week March
VIRGINIA	3rd week March
PENNSYLVANIA	1st week April
MINNESOTA	2nd week April
Upper NEW ENGLAND	2nd week April
